8. Perform audits and submit reports to the Quality Manager on planned intervals.
9. Review and evaluate basic Statistical Process Control charts for trends and special cause events.
10. Perform other tasks as directed by the Director.
11. Process material in the MRB Quarantine Area in a timely manner.
12. Reviews and maintains NCR log.
13. Willingness and ability to travel to customer sites and perform installations or inspections as required.
